

Terms and conditions

Tickets are subject to the availability of Nicholas McDonald. Neither the venue, nor the choir will be responsible for contacting ticket holders in the event of any cancellation. If notice of such a cancellation is received by the choir up to 12 midday on the day of the event, a web-posting will be made on the choir website www.bothwellphil.co.uk. Please check the website ahead of making travel arrangements.

No compensation will be considered in the event of any cancellation. Neither the venue, nor the choir can be considered liable for injury at the event, personal belongings brought to the venue, nor for refusal of access to the event if the ticket holder arrives later than their ticket admission time or is unable to pay in cash for tickets.

One ticket is required for every attendee who will meet with Nicholas. Any child under 16 MUST be supervised by an accompanying adult. One adult can supervise more than one child, but no more than one adult per child will be admitted. No other siblings, babies or adults will be admitted. No persons other than the ticket holder (and in respect of a child under 16, a single responsible accompanying adult) will be admitted.

Several ticket holders will attend at once. The venue and choir reserves the right to deny entrance or request that any event attendee leave ahead of completing their visit, if their behaviour could or is disturbing the enjoyment of other attendees.

The event will close promptly at 7.00 and only those attendees already holding concert tickets can remain in the building.
